#### **Teams and Divisions**

- Dependant on registrations and volunteers
- Team sizes max at 11 runners + 1 goalie
- Peanut (2017) through to Intermediate (2000)
- Boys and Girls Local League

- Stick contact only, body to body contact is prohibited

#### **Facilities**

- Indoor box lacrosse as much as possible
- Outdoor practice opportunities available
- Shared floor time to reduce costs
- Two floor times per week

### Bench Staff & Volunteers

- Two coaches, and one trainer per team
  - Coaches require: Criminal Record Check, NCCP Making Headway, and the Emergency Action Plan online course from the CAC locker
- Additional volunteers will be required to assist with and coordinate COVID-19 regulations
- Lacrosse training, and coaching support will be available for those that are able to help out
- Regular Bench staff meetings for protocol and practice support

# Scheduling

- Assessments April 19 May 16 8 floor times
  - Boys and Girls programming may have a delayed start
- Spring Games May 17 June 27 6 games over 12 floor times
  - After completion of the Spring games, team conferences will be regrouped for the start of the Summer Games. Last two weeks will be in team quarantine, with practices only
- Summer Games June 28 August 8 6 games over 12 floor times
- Teams from within the Wellington Dufferin Guelph Public Health Unit are highest priority to connect with and schedule for programming
